The Idaho Golf Association (IGA) is a 501 (c)(7) non-profit organization founded in 1969 with the goal of being an all encompassing umbrella organization for amateur golf in Idaho. The mission of the IGA is to promote the best interest of amateur golf, by providing playing opportunities for members, education, and protecting the spirit of the game. The IGA is comprised of approximately 17,000 members and approximately 75 member clubs.

The IGA is governed by a Board of Directors comprised of fourteen men and women who serve three-year terms. Operations are administered by seven full-time employees and USGA P.J. Boatwright Interns. Eighteen state championships and various USGA qualifiers are conducted each year in addition to over 35 events on the Idaho Junior Tour.

Employment Basics:

Position Description:

- District Coordinator for Northern District Events
 - six one-day events
 - one two-day event (District Championship)
 - Optional: Idaho Junior Am (IGA will pay extra fee and travel expenses)

General Idaho Junior Tour Responsibilities:

- Onsite Tournament official at assigned district events
- Responsible for all onsite tournament operations:
 - Starting
 - Scoring
 - Coordinating Volunteers
 - Photos of winners in each division
- Answer Rules of Golf questions at events
- Responsible for answering questions and inquiries about the Idaho Junior Tour:
 - how to sign up for events
 - points system
 - tour policies
 - how to qualify for districts and Idaho Junior Am
- Responsible for submitting results to Junior Tour staff
- Scoreboards
- Scorecards
- Part of the Junior Tour Committee (meetings twice a year: Spring and Fall)
